GENERAL ELECTION
VOTE—TUESDAY,
NOVEMBER 3rd 2020



PLEASE TAKE NOTE WHERE TO VOTE:

Precinct 1 Livonia Residents who live on the **WEST** side of US Hwy 169 and East of County Rd 1 vote at the Minnesota Propane Association Building (Formally Fresh Waters Church) located at 12475 273rd Ave near the intersection of 273rd Ave and US Hwy 169. Directions from the stop light at County Rd 4 and County Rd 45: go North on County Rd 45 to 273rd Ave (1 1/2 miles). Go East (right) on 273rd Ave 1/2 mile to Minnesota Propane Association Building entrance on the right. Directions from the stop light at Hwy 169 and County Rd 4: go North on Hwy 169 to 273rd Ave (1 1/2 miles). Go West (left) on 273rd Ave and turn South (left) into Minnesota Propane Association Building entrance.

Precinct 2 Livonia Residents who live on the **EAST** side of US Hwy 169 vote in the Town Hall Building located at 11162 265th Ave. Directions from the stop light at Hwy 169 and County Rd 4: go East on County Rd 4 to County Rd 39 (1 1/2 miles). Go North (left) on County Rd 39 1/2 mile to 265th Ave. Go East (right) on 265th Ave to Town Hall entrance.

Precinct 3 Livonia Residents who live on the **WEST** side of County Rd 1 also vote at the Minnesota Propane Association Building (Formally Fresh Waters Church) located at 12475 273rd Ave near the intersection of 273rd Ave and US Hwy 169. Directions from the stop light at County Rd 4 and County Rd 45: go North on County Rd 45 to 273rd Ave (1 1/2 miles). Go East (right) on 273rd Ave 1/2 mile to Minnesota Propane Association Building entrance on the right. Directions from the stop light at Hwy 169 and County Rd 4: go North on Hwy 169 to 273rd Ave (1 1/2 miles). Go West (left) on 273rd Ave and turn South (left) into Minnesota Propane Association Building entrance.

POLLS OPEN: Polls open at 7:00 am and close at 8:00 pm. Voters waiting in line at closing time are allowed to register/vote. Those who arrive after the closing hour are not.

VOTER ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible to vote, a person must be 18 years of age or older the day of the election, a US citizen, and have maintained residence in MN for 20 days preceding the election.

YOU NEED TO REGISTER IF: You have moved, changed your name, just became eligible to vote, or have not voted in the last four years. Voter registration applications are available at the Township or County Offices. You can register on Election Day with the proper identification and proof of residency. To save time at the poll, you can register now.

ABSENTEE VOTING: Please contact Sherburne County Auditor/Treasurer’s Office at 763-765-4351 for application for absentee ballot.

AN OPPORTUNITY TO SERVE YOUR COMMUNITY

Town supervisors are charged with the duty to make decisions on behalf of the Township and have the responsibility to see the Town fulfill its duties to the State and to the Town residents.

- ◆ The position of Supervisor C and Supervisor E will be up for election in March 2021. Both Supervisor C-Term and Supervisor E-Term are for 3 years.
- ◆ Filing for office will be held for a two week period beginning Tuesday, December 29, 2020 at 8:00 am and closing Tuesday, January 12, 2021 at 5:00 pm.
- ◆ Affidavits of Candidacy shall be filed with the Town Clerk/Treasurer at the Livonia Town Hall located at 11162 265th Avenue in Livonia Township. The filing fee is \$2.00. Filing can be done during regular office hours.
- ◆ To be eligible to run for Town office you must be:
An eligible voter, a filed candidate for only one position at the same election, at least 21 years of age at the time of assuming office and a resident of the Township for at least 30 days before the election.

A supervisor should have sufficient time throughout the year to attend meetings, listen to concerned residents, serve on various committees, attend training sessions to learn and remain current on the duties of office.

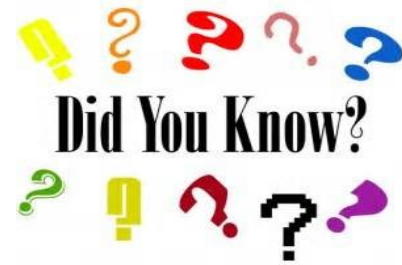

****Vandalism** of Township property results in increased property taxes. Traffic control and street signs that are stolen or vandalized are expensive to replace. Cleaning up the garbage dumped in Township right-of-ways also becomes expensive to remove. ****Animal Control.** Each time the Animal Control Officer goes out on a call, whether he impounds a dog or not, the Township is charged a \$40 fee. If the dog is impounded and not claimed by the owner, the Township is charged a \$60 impound fee. These fees are paid through tax levy and you can help control this cost by keeping your animals on your property or on a leash when off your property. If you happen to have a lost dog on your property please call the office at 763-856-5640 during business hours or call Sherburne County Sheriff's Department non-emergency phone number 763-765-3500 after hours, weekends and holidays.

SNOW SEASON WILL BE UPON US SOON

Some Reminders on Livonia Township's Snow Removal Policy...

- The plows are called out when an accumulation of 3 or more inches has fallen. They are not sent out until the snowfall has stopped or it is an extended snowfall of more than 6 inches.
- Plows will not be sent out during a time when poor visibility would make plowing dangerous.
- The Township is not responsible for: snow thrown in driveways, repair or replacement of mailboxes, fences, obstructions, etc., damaged by thrown snow or equipment hitting the above objects, or damage to landscaping done within the Right-of-Way.
- It is against the law to plow snow from your driveway across a public road.
- With safety in mind, please make sure the Right-of-Way is clear of all objects and obstructions. This will help with the timeliness of plowing and the safety of our drivers and trucks. This includes garbage receptacles in the road especially during a snowfall.
- All township roads will be limited to 5 ton axle weight when road restrictions are put in place by MNDOT. Truck operators are urged to call MNDOT 1-800-723-6543 for road postings.

WINTER PARKING

Residents are reminded to remove parked vehicles from the roadways during the winter months. According to Livonia Township's Parking Ordinance, it is unlawful to stop, park or stand any vehicle or parts thereof, on any roadway within the Township between November 1st and May 1st. Any vehicle or parts thereof left on any road, street, highway or thoroughfare in the Township in such a way as to impede the performance of any Town, City, County and/or State snowplow will be subject to the penalty provision of this Ordinance.
