



Public Hearing Minutes of the Livonia Town Board
Held at the Livonia Town Hall
Monday October 25, 2021

Butch Hass, Chairman of the Town Board, called the public hearing to order at 6:32 pm.

Supervisors present: Hass, Hiller, and Maloney

Staff present: Clerk/Treasurer Hammre and Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Fiedler

Chairman Hass: The purpose of the public hearing is for the Town Board to receive public input and take action on the vacation of a portion of the drainage and utility easement on the common lot line between Lot 1 and Lot 3, Block 1 in the plat of Cranberry Hill Farms, Livonia Township, Sherburne County, Minnesota. The hearing is recorded for the official record. Discussions will be limited to the stated purpose of the hearing. Anyone wishing to comment or ask questions will be allowed to do so. No speaker will be permitted to speak more than twice except to answer a question from the Board. Each speaker will be limited to a total of 3 minutes. No interruptions are permitted. Each person wishing to speak is asked to step up to the Board in order to have their comments properly understood and recorded for the official record. All comments must be directed to the chair. Each speaker must state his or her name, address and the group he or she represents, if any, before speaking. The Board may ask questions of the speakers.

Chairman Hass declared the Public Hearing Open. There were no audience questions or comments. There were no written comments.

Chairman Hass declared the Public Meeting Closed at 6:36 pm.

Chairman Hass asked for Board Discussion. There was no Board discussion.
